Do you qualify?

- At MSU Care, we provide basic medical care and prescription medication, free of charge, by appointment, to uninsured patients 18 – 64 years of age who are US citizens.
- Mental health services are available.
- Patients cannot be eligible for and/or receiving MO HealthNet, Medicare or any other health coverage.
- Patient or their family income needs to equal or be less than 150% of the Federal Poverty Level.

Bring these items to Clinic to complete enrollment:

- ✓ Current photo ID.
- ✓ Two months recent pay stubs for everyone in the household.
- ✓ Food Stamp Award letter including current name, address and benefit amount.
- ✓ Previous year's federal income tax return. (If taxes not filed, MSU Care will verify.)
- ✓ Applicant provides documentation of eligibility of federal, state, or other income benefit assistance including, but not limited to, SSI, SSD, VA, and/or Worker's Compensation for everyone in the household.
- ✓ Some applicants may be asked to provide a recent Medicaid denial letter, verification of shelter, and/or a letter of health insurance termination.

MSU Care eligibility is in effect for six months, unless you obtain Medicaid (MO HealthNet), Medicare or any other health coverage.
